## MagicDraw™ UML 7.0 released.

***Web Service, XML Schema and MDA tool integration added in the latest release of the leading UML modeling tool.***

This versatile development tool increases productivity of and communication among business and software analysts, architects, programmers, quality assurance engineers and documentation writers.

UML is rapidly gaining widespread acceptance throughout the world by various users, each with diverse and specific needs. To address these varied needs, No Magic has expanded its product line by adding two new products and revising the Professional Edition to offer programming language specific versions. The MagicDraw product line now consists of the Personal, Standard, Professional and Enterprise Editions along with the Teamwork Server.

The Personal Edition is a basic UML tool for drawing and publishing UML models. The Standard Edition is targeted for application architects and systems designers. The Professional Edition now is being offered in three language specific versions – Java, C++ and C#. The Enterprise Edition offers full UML support, Web Service code generation and database modeling.

Significant extensions in MagicDraw’s Open API allow for seamless integration with MDA tools. iO-Software, a strategic partner, already has replaced Rational Rose with MagicDraw as the UML modeling tool in their ArcStyler™ environment.

The following is a partial list of MagicDraw Version 7.0 features and enhancements:

- **XML Schema 1.1, WSDL 1.1, EJB 2.0 and CORBA IDL 3.0 code engineering**
- **Teamwork Server enhancements with IDE integrations**
- **Partitioning** – Version 7.0 provides large file support; the user can now partition large files into multiple modules.
- **Seven new types of diagrams are supported:**
  - Content diagram.
  - Web Application diagram.
  - Robustness diagram.
  - CORBA IDL diagram.
  - DDL diagram.
  - WSDL diagram.
  - XML Schema diagram.
- **Open API enhancements** – Version 7.0 allows the user to access all UML metamodel classes. The user may create a new diagram type extending the existing UML diagrams; the user may add panels into model elements' specification dialogs.

- **Pervasive database support.**
